

Middle/ High School Supply List

Mrs. Wyatt - Middle/High School Math:

All students will need

- 2 packs loose notebook paper (1 pack in binder 1 pack kept in cubby as needed)
- pencils (extra lead if buying mechanical pencils)
- small pack of pencil erasers
- 1 small pack dry erase markers with erasers (these do dry out quickly and we use them often in class. Students may need to purchase additional dry erase markers as needed throughout the year).
- highlighters (small pack)
- index cards (1 pack of 100 count or greater)
- 1 pack notebook dividers (about 3 dividers)
- 1 folder with pockets
- 1 pack loose grid paper (No spiral grid notebooks)
- small pack of colored pencils
- earbuds (something cheap is preferable)
- ruler
- pencil bag (bag must be large enough for 2-3 each of pencils, dry erase markers, highlighters, and the small pack of colored pencils, earbuds, and ruler but small enough to fit in binder with paper. No pencil boxes in class. Pencil boxes can be kept in the students cubby for extra items)

Special items

6th, 7th, 12th grade will need a 2 inch binder

8th grade will need a 2.5-3 inch binder

9th/10th grade will need a 2.5 -3 inch binder, protractor, and compass
